Dr. İbrahim Aşık, MD, FIPP is a clinical professor in Pain Medicine and head of the Department of Algology, in Medical Faculty of Ankara University, Turkey. After graduating medical school, he started the Anesthesiology residency in 1991 at University of Ankara, Faculty of Medicine, Anesthesiology and Pain Department Ankara, Turkey. After residency, he studied in Multidisciplinary Pain Center İn Ann Arbor at University of Michigan and he participated in experimental studies about spinal pain in Wayne State University, Bioengineering Center, Detroit, in 1999. He is board certified and pain specialist in Turkey since 2011, and Fellow of Interventional Pain Practice (FIPP) since 2007. His areas of clinical interest are interventional treatments of neck and low back pain and neuromodulation in failed back and neck patients. Dr. Aşık is the current co-chair of WIP Turkish Registered Section. He is the author of more than 100 publications in peer reviewed journals and in editorial board of several journals. He organized 5 national symposiums and two international workshops.
